## Volunteer Internships

In addition to the paid apprentice position, we are also offering 1-2 month volunteer internships in the Nursery and/or Farm throughout the 2018 growing season. These positions require a minimum half-day commitment for one day per week, for a minimum 4 weeks at a time. These positions require less of a time commitment than the apprentice position, and we are often able to send volunteers home with produce or plants. If you're interested in volunteering if the paid position doesn't work out, please indicate that in your application. If you're not selected for the apprenticeship, please email us with '2018 Volunteer Internship' as the subject. Let us know if you'd prefer to be in the nursery, on the farm, or both.

Volunteer Nursery Internship positions start in early March and can run as late as end of June, when the Nursery closes for the season.
